

My Team




- We are a Cross Functional and Multi-Geo team
- We employ a 3rd Party Vendor
- We work across Multiple Organizations within Intel

Our Journey

- 70% HC turnover in 2015 and 2016
- Running Waterfall with "tribal knowledge"
- Historically projects would run up to 1 year late
- Customer Confidence was very low
- Vendor viability was questionable

Our Solution?

- Engaged with Customer to institute Agile
- Held intact trainings with the customer
- Instituted Regular Product Demos and Retrospectives
- Defined a proxy Product Owner
- Daily Standups held <u>DAILY</u>



Common Obstacles to Adoption

- "My Manager doesn't believe in 'Agile', thinks it's a buzz-word"
- "Our organizational structure doesn't align with Agile"
- "Not all team members are co-located"
- Your organization is project centered vs team centered
- PROJECT MILESTONES are the norm
- "I don't have time for all these meetings"
- Following Agile by the book
- "There is no 'Plan' in Agile"

Follow the Ceremony

Sprint Planning

- Involve the Product Owner
- Prioritize the Backlog
- Sprint Ahead
- Be conscientious of the Product Owners time




DSU
