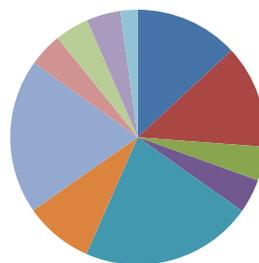
Additional Information about the PMI Portland Chapter Annual Conference

Speaker Guidelines

The purpose of the conference is to provide educational value. Speaker topics and messages deliver educational value and are focused on providing skills and/or participant action items which will give or improve project/program management competencies or improve participant effectiveness in leading.

The Speaker Committee will select speakers based on the most appropriate topics, speakers experience as a professional speaker, and references supplied by members, the speakers and other sources.

Speakers should refrain from giving any sales pitches or sale promotions during the presentation. Handouts are acceptable but should be congruent with message and approved in advance by the speaker committee. Handout replication is the responsibility of the speaker.

All speakers are expected to adhere to the PMI Code of Ethics, a copy of which is attached to 2014 Presenters Proposal and Agreement Form.

The PMI Portland Chapter does not distribute member information so many speakers collect business cards via a raffle item basket. This should be discussed in advance with the Speaker Committee.

We do not provide honoraria to track speakers. Speakers are expected to cover travel and hotel expenses (if applicable). Special registration instructions will be provided to those selected by the Speakers Committee.
