



2011 Excellence in Project Management Awards Project Manager of the Year Award

The Project Management Institute (PMI) Portland Chapter is sponsoring the 2011 Excellence in Project Management Project Manager of the Year Award. This award honors the accomplishments of a Project Manager, who has been certified through PMI, and who has demonstrated Project Management excellence through the effective management of resources, schedule and scope. The Project Manager will have exhibited leadership qualities using project methodology to ensure successful project outcomes. An award ceremony will be held to honor the Project Manager.

The primary goals of the award are to:

- Recognize, honor, and widely publicize the achievements of a Project Manager, certified through PMI, for demonstrated use of project management methodology to achieve successful project outcomes in the Portland metro and SW Washington communities.
- Increase awareness of Project Management principles as described in PMBOK (Project Management Book of Knowledge) and their direct contribution to Project Manager performance.
- Increase business community awareness of PMI (Project Management Institute) and the PMI mission.

Eligibility

Project Managers, certified through PMI from throughout the Portland metro and SW Washington areas are encouraged to participate. The following are eligible:

- All Project Managers that manage structured projects, regardless of size, industry, or type of product or process produced.
- **Project Managers who managed projects completed between January 1, 2011 and December 31, 2011.**
- Project Managers who manage projects resulting in a positive customer impact and that meet the standards of quality through the effective management of resources, schedule and scope.

The following Project Managers are not eligible:

- Project Managers who apply for recognition of their Project Management performance on projects which have been managed while under contract to PMI, directly or indirectly.
- Project Managers who are currently involved as PMI staff, contractors and/or consultants. PMI volunteers are encouraged to apply.

Award Criteria

Awards will be judged on an assessment of some, but not necessarily all, of the following criteria:

- Demonstration of the Project Manager's ability to achieve excellence through the use of the five process groups and nine knowledge areas identified in PMI's Project Management Body of Knowledge (PMBOK).
- Demonstration of the Project Manager's ability to manage, motivate, inform and enable the project team to achieve customer satisfaction within the three constraints of resources, schedule and scope to meet requirements in delivering a quality project.
- Recognition of the Project Manager's qualities which include, but are not limited to, effective communication, personal integrity and leadership.

Application Process

- The application process will begin **March 1, 2012** and completed applications to be electronically submitted by **April 30, 2012**.
- Winner will be notified and invited to attend the PMI-Portland Chapter Dinner and EPMA Award Ceremony on **June 19, 2012**.

1. Project Managers may nominate themselves – simply fill out the application via the link below.
2. Project Managers may be nominated by peers, team members or professional acquaintances by sending a note to awards@pmi-portland.org with the name of the individual, the email address and the phone number. Tell us whether you would like your name to be known by the nominee or whether this is an anonymous recommendation. We will contact the Project Manager and let him/her know that someone nominated him/her.

3. Project Managers may be nominated by peers, team members or professional acquaintances by contacting the individual directly and recommending that the award process be pursued.
